Responsibilities

- To take full responsibility for the classes for which they are responsible.
- To maintain high ethical standards in coaching, ensure they keep upto-date with their knowledge, skills and qualifications and prepare all coaching sessions in advance.
- To undertake training appropriate to the role e.g. child protection training.
- To work with and include assistants in the preparation and running of each session.
- To offer the club feedback on the organisation, successes of the club.
- Shall ensure that the club risk assessment is valid before any class takes place
- Shall enforce the AWE Judo Club Rules
- Shall ensure that a record of all players participating in a every class under their control is kept
- Shall ensure that if they are unable to take a class they either cancel the class (making every effort to notify all members) or arrange an alternative (BJA qualified) Coach.
- Shall ensure that all players in a class has an up to date BJA licence
- Shall ensure that they are aware of any medical conditions of all the members of the class
- Shall record any injuries in the AWE Judo Club Injury Book.

Qualifications

- Member of the British Judo Association, that is, holds a valid BJA Licence.
- Holds a BJA Coaching, Club Coach (Level one two or three), that is, qualified to coach in a club up to the levels determined by the BJA.
- The coach must hold a current DBS & Safeguarding Certificates
- First Aid Trained
