<p>Responsibilities</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Assist the British Judo Association (BJA) to fulfil it's responsibilities to safeguard children at club level. • Assist the BJA to implement it's child protection plan at club level. • The first point of contact for staff, volunteers, parents and children where concerns about children's welfare, poor practice or child abuse are identified. • Be the first point of contact with the BJA Child Protection Officer. • Implement the BJA's reporting and recording procedures. • Maintain contact details for local Social Services, Police. Know how to obtain Area Child Protection Committee guidelines. • Promote the BJA's best practice guidance/code of conduct within the club. • Sit on the club's management committee • Promote and ensure adherence to the organization's child protection training plan. • Promote and ensure confidentiality is maintained. • Promote anti-discriminatory practice. 	
<p>Knowledge</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Basic knowledge of core legislation, government guidance and national framework for child protection • Basic knowledge of roles and responsibilities of statutory agencies (Social Services, Police and Area Child Protection Committees. • Local arrangement for managing child protection and reporting procedures. • Poor practice and abuse – behaviour that is harmful to children. • Own organisation's role and responsibilities to safeguard the welfare of children – boundaries of the Club Welfare Officer role. • Own organisation's policy and procedures related to safeguarding children. • Core values and principles underpinning practice. • Awareness of equalities issues and child protection 	
<p>Recommended Knowledge</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Basic knowledge of how abusers 'target' and 'groom' organisations to abuse children. Best practice in prevention.
